- From Sacramento, take I80 toward Rocklin
- Exit HWY 65 and go West
- Exit at Blue Oaks, go East, (avoid far right lane which takes you West to Roseville)
- Right turn at lights toward Rocklin (East)
- Left at Lone Tree Blvd (skip 1<sup>st</sup> Softball parking entrance, long walk to soccer fields)
- Right at West Oaks Blvd for Soccer Field parking lot, and across the street

### RULES AND PROCEDURES

**Sportsmanship:** The Quarry Blast is a soccer festival aimed at celebrating U9-U11 soccer and an introduction to Tournament style soccer. To that end, good sportsmanship will prevail at all times. Coaches are responsible for their players, parents, and spectators affiliated with the team. Rocklin Youth Soccer adheres to a "Zero Tolerance" policy when it comes to questioning calls, and as our guests, we request that you follow our local rules.

**Scoring:** We have done our best to seed teams based on D6 Seeding and early season results. However, if you find yourself in a mismatch, please respect your opponent and follow the 7 goal differential rule common to most tournaments.

**Referees:** A three person crew will work all games, including an experienced Center Referee and some of our newer referees serving as Assistant Referees to run the sidelines. This is a terrific opportunity for these younger referees to learn and work on their game before the regular season begins in September. We ask for your understanding with the crews and respect their efforts. Just as the players are learning the game at the higher level, so too are our referees. All referee decisions are final and no protests will be allowed.

NOT COVERED: The Tournament Committee will review any issues or problems that arise which are not specifically covered in this rules document. The committee reserves the right to establish policy as deemed necessary to deal with such matters. The decisions of the committee are final and there will be no appeals.

Check In: All teams must register together at least 30 minutes before game time. Coaches please bring roster on labels to affix to game cards.

Games: We are on a tight schedule with games scheduled for Friday night at 6-10, Saturday morning at 8-12, followed by an afternoon break and then resuming Saturday night at 6-10pm. Lights must go out by 10pm so timeliness is critical. Games will be 20 minute halves with a 5 minute half time. No additional time added. Shortened games or additional breaks may be added due to heat. Given the tight window, teams must be on the field ready to play 10 minutes before the scheduled starting time. All teams are guaranteed at least one game under the lights.

Home Team: The home team is listed first and will supply 3 game balls, one to begin the game and one at each goal. The Home Team will take the Northern sideline (closest to water park) and the Visitors, the Southern side. Home team must change uniform colors in case of conflict. No coin flips, as the Home team kicks off. Visitors will choose direction to defend.

**Uniforms:** All players will be inspected before each game so no jewelry or casts. Players must be in appropriate jerseys with numbers.

Cards: We do not expect any cards for a Jamboree. However, if a Yellow is issued, the player must be substituted. A Red Card will result in a minimum one game suspension. Red Cards will be reviewed by the Jamboree Director and the Referee Coordinator using CYSA guidelines.

**Alcohol and Tobacco:** Alcohol is not permitted at any of the fields. Any coaches, parents or affiliated spectators found violating this rule will face possible expulsion from the Jamboree. Smoking is not permitted on our fields or within 50 feet of any parks.

Awards: No standings will be kept and all players will receive the same awards that will be given to all teams. Pins and medals are available to all players and coaches. Scores of games will be posted at the main concession area.

#### Jamboree Fees are Non-Refundable

Concessions will be available at the main field. As this is a Rocklin U9-U11 fundraising event, we respectfully ask that you patronize our efforts to serve and refresh you! Coffee drinks and smoothies, baked goods and additional treats will be available to quench your thirst and satisfy your snack needs!

**Shade:** They don't call it Lone Tree Park for nothing! Although the Soccer Club planted lots of trees in the past few years, the shade is a few years away so bring those canopies for the sunny games!

**Water Feature Playground:** Lone Tree Park has a popular water playground so please pass the word to your parents and players to bring towels and extra clothes if they venture in. It is a great way to cool off after the games!
