## ***Indoor Kickball 2025 - 26***

***All teams will be responsible for paying \$13 CASH to the umpire before the start of each game. Failure to pay the umpire will result in a forfeit.***

### ***Leagues Offered:***

All teams will play a 6-game season and a double elimination tournament. Teams will select to play in the Competitive or the Recreational Division. Leagues will not be mixed unless we don't have a minimum of 4 teams in each league for play to be scheduled separately.

#### **Competitive:**

- Competitive teams play to win first and have fun second.
- More skilled athletes.

#### **Recreational:**

- Rec teams play to have fun and aren't as concerned about winning or losing.
- Teams are filled with friends or co-workers looking to get some exercise.

### ***Registration and Fees (per team):***

- **Registration:** October 6th – November 16<sup>th</sup> (in person or online)  
All teams: **\$268.00** (\$250.00 plus tax\*)

\*Due to bill LB 727 all adult recreation is taxed at 7.25% sales tax.

### ***Season Dates:***

- The season begins Sunday, December 7<sup>th</sup> and ends in early-March.
- No games will be scheduled for Super Bowl Sunday, February 8, 2026.

### ***General Information:***

- Teams play with 6 players on defense; up to 10 can kick.
- **Mixed Coed – Minimum of 2 of a different gender to play.**
- Regular season will be pool play. Teams will be divided up based on skill level for the tournament.
- Games could be cancelled due to weather conditions; we suggest that all teams/players sign up for text alert notification via [www.teamsideline.com/lincolne](http://www.teamsideline.com/lincolne)
- Games will be played every hour.
