

2025 Fall Bocce – Quick Scoring Guide

✓ Step 1: Complete the Score Sheet

- Fill in after each game.
- Both captains sign at the end.
- Take a photo of the board or sheet to avoid disputes.

✓ Step 2: Email the Score Sheet

- Winning captain emails the sheet to: **SCORE@RFME.org**
- **Do not text** score sheets.

✓ Step 3: Auto Coach Scoring

- Home captain/co-captain will get an email with a **scoring link**.
- Enter scores for BOTH teams using the link (not the phone app).
- Two reminders will be sent if scores aren't entered.
- For make-up games: use the original email link from the scheduled date.

✓ Step 4: Confirm Submission

- Both steps are required:
 1. Email the signed score sheet.
 2. Enter scores via Auto Coach Scoring.
- If the winning and home captain are the same, that captain does both.

2025 Fall Bocce – Expanded Scoring Guide

2025 Fall Bocce Scoring Information

For the Fall Bocce league, we will continue with the same process as previous seasons, with few changes. Here is a quick summary of the scoring process in 4 easy steps:

1. **COMPLETE THE PAPER SCORE SHEET**. During the match, the paper score sheet is filled out after each game. Please record scores after each game and take a picture of the scoreboard to avoid discrepancies. Both captains need to sign the paper score sheet.

2. **EMAIL THE COMPLETED PAPER SCORE SHEET**. After the match, both team captains sign the completed paper score sheet. The WINNING TEAM captain emails the paper score sheet to Roger Wright at SCORE@RFME.ORG

3. **AUTO SCORING EMAIL**. Before, during or after the match, an Auto Scoring email will be sent to the HOME TEAM* captain/co-captain with a link to submit the match scores for both teams. Only one person, the captain OR co-captain can submit the scores, so decide ahead of time who will submit the scores via the link. Click on the link to submit match scores for both teams. If scores are not submitted after the match, 2 reminder emails will be sent to submit the scores via the Auto Score link.

Auto Scoring can be used for make-up games, but the HOME TEAM captain will need to go back to the original email that was sent at the time of the originally scheduled game and use that link.

* HOME TEAM is designated on the Game Schedules located in Team Sideline, at the top of the game schedules.

4. **AFTER THE MATCH**. At the end of the match, the HOME TEAM captain will use the link to enter ALL of the scores from the match.

HELPFUL TIPS/INFORMATION

1. Auto Scoring does not replace the paper score sheet. The WINNING Captain must email the final score sheet enter. The HOME Team Captain will enter the scores via the Auto Score link. On occasion the WINNING and HOME Team Captain will be the same, and will send the paper score sheet and enter scores via the Auto Score link.
2. It is strongly suggested to take a picture of the scoring board after each game to avoid discrepancies.
- 3 Auto Scoring can be used for make-up games, but the HOME TEAM captain will need to go back to the original email that was sent at the time of the originally scheduled game and use that link.
4. Do not use the Team Sideline phone application to enter your scores. Scores can only be entered using the link in your email inbox.
5. Sorry, but due to personal constraints, you cannot text the score sheet. It must be emailed to SCORE@RFME.org. It is suggested that you save this in your contacts to make it easy to send the email when out on the courts.
