

## 2025 Adult Summer Softball League Information

Please pass on information to another team member or request our office to forward it if you are not the contact/manager this year. New teams are placed into leagues on a first come, first served basis after returning teams. **Adult summer softball leagues at Dawson Softball Complex will start the week of May 5<sup>th</sup> and consist of 12 games.**

### ROSTERS

- Rosters are due to the Recreation office no later than **Friday, April 4<sup>th</sup> at noon**, with all fees paid in full.
- Rosters **MUST** have full name, address and phone numbers on them in order to be complete. Incomplete rosters will **NOT** be accepted.
- Manager e-mails are REQUIRED for our Team Sideline website.

### LEAGUE FEES

- The team fee is \$460 and must be paid in full at the time of registration which includes up to 20 players.
- A \$50.00 late fee will be charged to all teams that do not submit their roster and fees by April 4<sup>th</sup>.
- Teams turning in rosters/fees after the deadline will lose their returning team status. **No late rosters will be accepted after April 11<sup>th</sup>.**
- All sponsored teams must have their sponsorship payment in full at the time of registration. If you are paying on your own, please submit one check.

### MANAGER'S MEETING: MONDAY, APRIL 14<sup>TH</sup>, 2025

There will be a Manager's pre-season meeting for all leagues. Meetings will be virtual via Microsoft Teams. A link for the meeting will be emailed to all team managers ahead of time. Meetings will cover the Player Code of Conduct, rule changes and updates, league placement and any other league information. **If the team manager can't attend, a team member should be present. Teams without representation won't have a say in their league placement.**

### RETURNING & NEW TEAM STATUS

Teams with 5 or more returning players from the previous season are considered returning teams and will have priority in league placement if registered by the deadline of Friday, April 4<sup>th</sup>.

### BATS

The City of Janesville Softball Leagues will continue to adhere to the ASA bat list. Anyone found using an illegal bat will be automatically ejected as well as the person that brought the bat and suspended for one game. ### PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

The roster includes a sign-off for players to confirm they've read and understood the City of Janesville Player Code of Conduct. Managers are responsible for ensuring all players sign the roster. This replaces the former individual code of conduct forms.

### PRACTICE RESERVATIONS

Teams may sign up to reserve a diamond for one hour to practice the week before leagues start for \$12/hour. To reserve a practice time, please do so at the time of registration or by stopping into the Recreation Office. The last team should close the gate and lock the padlock after their practice is complete.

- There will be no Supervisor on site for practices.
- The concession stands and bathrooms will not be available.
- No alcohol is allowed in the complex during practice times. If found practice privileges may be lost.
