
WOODBURY PARKS & RECREATION 2026 Winter Pickleball League Registration Packet



Thank you for your interest in the Winter Pickleball Leagues offered by Woodbury Parks & Recreation and in partnership with All-World Pickleball. REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- ✓ To register a team, the manager/individual must submit league registration and full payment during the appropriate registration period. **No registration will be accepted without payment.** A team is not given a spot until all fees are paid. The following is a list of different ways to register your team.
 - ONLINE: Register online at https://www.woodburymn.gov/384/Recreation. Click on the box labeled register or view programs and events. You will be directed to our registration login page. Create an account and login. Once logged in, click on the search tab and select type ADULT
 SPORT LEAGUES. This will bring you to the list of adult leagues we are offering this upcoming season. Click on the empty square box in front of the activity #. The selected league will appear at the bottom of the screen, click "Add to Cart" button to proceed to checkout.
 - 2. **EMAIL OR PHONE:** Call the league director at 651-414-3475 to register over the phone or email registration materials to samuel.jenes@woodburymn.gov. Credit card payment is required.
 - 3. **IN-PERSON:** In-person registration is accepted Monday–Friday; 8:00 am–4:30 pm within the registration dates. The Recreation Department is located on the 2nd floor inside the Woodbury City Hall building (8301 Valley Creek Road, Woodbury, MN 55125).
 - 4. **DROP-BOX (after hours):** Place your registration within the registration dates in a sealed envelope labeled 'PICKLEBALL' and leave it in the after-hours utility payment deposit box located in the parking lot median at Woodbury City Hall.
 - 5. MAIL: Mail to Woodbury Parks and Recreation, 8301 Valley Creek Road, Woodbury, MN 55125.

LEAGUE INFORMATION

- ✓ When will we know what league we got into?
 You will receive a receipt when you register that will show the league your team is registered for.
- ✓ **How will I receive my scores and standings as an individual?**Individual scores will be posted on TeamSideline using your first initial and last name i.e. J. Doe. All-World Pickleball also has their own scoring system they use on-site. If you would like something else to be listed for privacy reasons, please reach out to the league director, Tucker Jenes. ✓ How do I sign up?

- 1. For the Monday league, only the team manager needs to sign up and pay. They will then be responsible for adding the rest of their team to the roster. **Please note:** You <u>must</u> have a partner already agreed to be your teammate <u>before</u> you sign up for the league.
- 2. For all other leagues, individuals must sign up and pay for themselves.

✓ What should I do if I know I will miss a week?

Reach out to All-World Pickleball or the league director ahead of time. All-World has a list of people that could sub in for you if needed. If you are in the Monday league and you or a partner will be missing, follow the same steps. If your whole team is missing for a week of the Monday league, please reach out to the league director as soon as you know you'll be absent.

✓ What are the roster and eligibility requirements?

- 1. Minimum age for players is 18.
- 2. A roster is only required for the Monday partner league.
- 3. The **minimum** number of players on a roster is 2 and the **maximum** number of players that may be on the roster is 6.
- 4. Players must be listed on the team roster in order to play in league and/or post season matches players are only allowed to be on one team roster per league night.
- 5. In the event that a team disbands before the scheduled matches are complete, all the remaining matches will be credited to their scheduled opponent. No refund will be made.

✓ Do I need to send a team roster now?

No. **A roster is not required until your first match.** Team rosters are turned in through the league website, www.teamsideline.com/woodburymn. Instructions will be provided to manager in the league welcome email.

✓ What equipment do I need to bring with me?

All individuals must provide their own paddles. All-World Pickleball will be providing match balls for teams to use throughout the duration of the night. They will be provided by the on-sight league attendant. If you sign up for the beginner league on Sundays, All-World Pickleball will provide you with a paddle if you need one. We want anyone who wants to join to be able to.

✓ What times are matches played and where?

See the table below for all scheduled match times. All games will be played at All-World Pickleball (11650 Hudson Rd Suite 200)

✓ When will we get our schedules?

The Monday partners league will receive their schedules roughly 1-2 weeks before the start of the league. All other leagues will receive their matchups on sight from the All-World Pickleball staff.

✓ What are the Manager's Duties?

- 1. Make sure you have a team ready each week.
- 2. You, the manager, must handle any dispute.
- 3. You are responsible for taking charge of your team's and your spectator's conduct.
- 4. Any schedule information, changes or other league information will be sent to you. Make sure we have a way to contact you. Pass the information along to your teammate(s).
- 5. Know the rules and review the rules with your team. This will help the match run smoothly and help your team concentrate on playing.

✓ What is the refund/cancellation policy?

- 1. If Woodbury Parks & Recreation cancels a league due to low numbers, a full refund will be given.
- 2. If a team/individual chooses to back out of the league after the registration deadline, no refund will be given.
- 3. If matches are cancelled due to poor weather conditions and no make-up dates are available, a program refund will be issued based on the number of matches missed.

SELF RATING SYSTEM & DEFINITIONS

Levels: Beginner 0-2.5; Intermediate 3-3.5; Advanced 4-4.5; Expert 5+

Rating 1.0

• New player with understanding of the game and rules.

Rating 1.5

- Can hit the ball back and forth a bit.
- Learning to serve.
- Fails to hit easy balls frequently.
- Beginning to learn the basic rules such as scoring, lines, side outs, etc.

Rating 2.0

- Sustains short rallies.
- Makes basic strokes such as forehand, backhand, volley, and can serve the ball.
- Understands court positioning and doubles rules.

Rating 2.5

- Can sustain longer rallies but not at a fast pace.
- Makes most easy shots, including backhands, but still needs some work.
- Able to approach the non-volley zone and hit volleys.
- Good understanding of the rules.
- Struggles to cover the entire court.

Rating 3.0

- Has a consistent serve and returns medium paced balls reliably.
- Able to make all basic strokes. Lacks control when trying to place the ball.
- Attempts lobs and dinks with limited success.

Rating 3.5

- Consistent control and placement of medium paced shots. Able to return fastpaced shots with slightly less success.
- Improved ball control and placement of the ball.
- Needs more shot variety.
- Can play aggressively at the non-volley zone.
- Anticipates opponent's shots and learning strategy of doubles play.

Rating 4.0

- Consistent with both forehand and backhand strokes.
- Can use spin with some success.
- May lose rallies due to impatience.
- Uses the dink and drop shot successfully.
- Demonstrates 3rd shot strategies.
- Aggressive net play in doubles.
- Full understanding of the rules.

Rating 4.5

- Beginning to master placement and spin.
- Beginning to master 3rd shot choices.
- Good footwork and positioning.
- •Adjusts game style to account for opponent's strengths, weaknesses, and court position.
- Good shot selection. Does not force shots.
- Serves consistently and can vary speed and spin.
- Good court positioning. Anticipates opponent's shot.

Rating 5.0

- Mastered all shot types.
- Excellent shot anticipation.
- Accurate shot placement.
- Forces errors. Limits their own unforced errors.
- Mastered dinks and dropshots.
- Mastered 3rd shot strategy
