
WOODBURY PARKS & RECREATION 2025-2026 Winter 8v8 Soccer League Registration Packet

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- ✓ To register for the league, you must submit league registration and full payment during the appropriate time period listed below. No registration will be accepted without payment. An individual is not given a spot until all fees are paid. Woodbury Parks & Recreation accepts payment by cash, check or credit card. The following is a list of different ways to register your team.
 - ONLINE: Register online at https://www.woodburymn.gov/384/Recreation. Click on the orange box in the middle of the page labeled register or view programs and events. You will be directed to our registration login page. Create an account and login. Once logged in, click on the search tab and select type ADULT SPORT LEAGUES. This will bring you to the list of adult leagues we are offering this upcoming season. Click on the empty square box in front of the activity #. The selected league will appear at the bottom of the screen, click "Add to Cart" button to proceed to checkout.
 - 2. **EMAIL:** Registrations can be submitted by email to samuel.jenes@woodburymn.gov.
 - 3. **PHONE:** Call Woodbury Parks and Recreation office at 651-714-3583 or the league director at 651-414-3436 to register over the phone. Credit card payment is required. Managers need to submit a hard copy of the registration and roster forms to complete the registration process.
 - 4. **IN-PERSON:** In-person registration is accepted at the Woodbury City Hall Welcome Desk Monday–Friday; 8:00 am–4:30 pm within the registration dates. Woodbury City Hall building address is 8301 Valley Creek Road, Woodbury, MN 55125.
 - 5. **DROP-BOX (after-hours):** Place your registration within the registration dates in a sealed envelope labeled 'SOCCER' and drop it in the after-hours in the silver utility payment deposit box located in the parking lot median at Woodbury City Hall.
 - 6. **MAIL:** Mail-in registration can be submitted within the registration dates to Woodbury Parks and Recreation Department, 8301 Valley Creek Road, Woodbury, MN 55125.

LEAGUE INFORAMATION

✓ Should I buy game balls?

Yes, all teams are asked to bring a game ball to the field on game days. Please coordinate with your teammates to decide who will provide a game ball each week. The city will provide a back-up game ball that can be used if both teams choose. If for some reason teams are unable to decide on a game ball they will be asked to use the ball provided by the city.

✓ What times are games played and where?

- 1.Game nights will generally start at 9:30, 10:30 p.m.
- 2.Games will be played at the M Health Fairview Sports Center field house.

✓ What are the roster and eligibility requirements?

- 1. Minimum age for players is 18.
- 2. Players must be listed on the team roster in order to play in the league.
- 3. In the event that a team disbands before the scheduled games are complete, all the remaining games will be credited to their scheduled opponent. No refund will be made.
- 4. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to place individuals on teams where there will be equalization of competition and/or allow teams opportunity to play.

√ When will we get our schedules?

All of your information, including game schedules and rosters will be emailed to the team in a group email once teams have been assigned. One week before the league starts at the latest. League materials will also be available on the league website, www.teamsideline.com/woodburymn.

√ What are your responsibilities to your teammates?

- 1. Make sure you keep other team members informed if you wind up missing a week. Try to find a sub if at all possible.
- 2. You must keep yourself in check. Do not let yourself face ejection by arguing a call.
- 3. You are responsible for taking charge of your and your spectator's conduct. Abusive language, improper drinking, litter and other irresponsible acts will not be tolerated.
- 4. Any schedule information, changes or other league information will be sent to you. Make sure we have your current email address for the current season. It is your responsibility to keep up with the information we send you.
- 5. Know the rules. This way the game will run smoothly & help your team concentrate on playing.

√ What is the refund/cancellation policy?

- 1. If Woodbury Parks & Recreation cancels a league due to low numbers, a full refund will be given.
- 2. If an individual chooses to back out of the league after the registration deadline, no refund will be given.
- 3. If games are cancelled and no make-up dates are available, a program credit will be issued for the amount of the official for that game. A couple make-up dates are built into the season.




WOODBURY PARKS & RECREATION Team Conduct, Eligibility, and Forfeit Fee Policy

Woodbury Park & Recreations has a Team Conduct, Eligibility, and Forfeit Fee Policy for Adult Athletic Leagues.

Teams will have to pay for the following violations before their next scheduled game. If fees are not paid before the next game, teams or players may not be allowed to play.

- <u>Alcohol Consumption</u> \$50 per incident. No alcohol can be consumed or taken into the bench, dugout or playing field. Outside of those areas alcohol is allowed (no hard liquor or glass bottles).
- <u>No Tobacco Products</u> \$25 per incident. M Health Fairview Sports Complex is a tobacco free facility
- <u>Physical contact made with an official or another player</u> \$100 per incident and expulsion from the league.
- Not having a complete roster on file for the current league \$25 per incident. Roster are due before the 1st game and need to be submitted electronically at http://www.teamsideline.com/woodburymn.
- <u>Player Ejection</u> \$50 per ejection. Any player who is ejected from a game, for any reason, will not be allowed to play in any games the remainder of the evening <u>and</u> suspended any games the following week. The ejected player must leave the facility. Failure to comply will result in the game being declared a forfeit. If the player is ejected a second time, suspension may cover additional games or possibly the remainder of the season depending on the severity of the incident.
- <u>Ineligible/Unrostered Player</u> \$25 per violation.
- <u>Unannounced Forfeit</u> \$25 per game. Less than 24 hours of scheduled game.
- <u>Loud or Vulgar Music</u> \$25 per incident. Loud or vulgar music is not allowed during games.

This policy will be enforced by the league director, City of Woodbury staff members, and league officials. All teams will be required to pay the required conduct fee once notified by the league director that a team and/or player violation has been made. Teams will have 48 hours to pay the fee and will not be able to continue in the league until the fee has been paid. No exceptions.



Adult Soccer Skill Definitions (Individual Registrations)

Recreational (C)

- You're here to have fun, meet people, and enjoy playing soccer!
- You know the basic rules but may not know all the finer details.
- Your passing, shooting, and control are developing and can be inconsistent.
- You're still getting comfortable with spacing, positioning, and teamwork.
- Perfect for newer or casual players.

Intermediate (B)

- You've played before and are comfortable with the basics passing, dribbling, and shooting.
- You understand positioning and can generally stay in formation.
- You make smart plays and communicate well with teammates.
- You like a little competition but still play for fun and good sportsmanship.
- Great for players with some prior league or pickup experience.

Competitive (A)

- You have strong technical skills and good control under pressure.
- You understand tactics, formations, and team structure in an 8v8 setting.
- You can anticipate plays and adjust quickly on both offense and defense.
- You're confident in your abilities and enjoy a faster-paced, competitive game.
- Best for experienced players who have played at higher levels or consistently in leagues.
