

ALL-STAR PARENT COMMITMENT LETTER 2025

When a child is selected as an All-Star, it is a great accomplishment. Along with that comes a great deal of responsibility and commitment. The All-Star season shall run from **May 2025 through August 2025**. The National tournaments are held during August which teams must qualify for. Teams will be competing in a minimum of four (4) tournaments, which can include games on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday. In addition to the tournaments, most coaches will hold four (4) to six (6) practices a week. It is of utmost importance to the team that all players are able to make a FULL COMMITMENT to the entire season. This includes practices and tournaments.

The fee to participate on an All-Star team is \$520 (five hundred twenty dollars) per player for the 8U / 10U / 12U / 14U / High School (16U / 18U) divisions which includes two (2) jerseys, one (1) dri-fit, a sticker pack, picture packet, three (3) tournaments, and the cost of Districts. In addition, each team is responsible and required to obtain a \$400 (four hundred dollars) Team Sponsor (sponsorship form available on MVGSA website). Should the team NOT obtain a sponsor, the team shall be responsible for the sponsorship fee. If this fee is not received by MVGSA prior to the beginning of the second tournament selected by MVGSA, the team will not be entered into any further tournaments until the fee is paid. These funds are important, as they help defray the cost of uniforms and tournament entry fees.

MVGSA shall furnish each player with a numbered All-Star jersey. 50% (fifty percent) of the REGISTRATION FEE MUST be PAID by Thursday, May 8th to cover the uniform costs OR your child's uniform will NOT BE ORDERED. The balance of your registration fee MUST be PAID prior to uniform pick up on Thursday May 22nd or you will NOT receive your child's uniform. NO EXCEPTIONS. Any other items shall be purchased separately at the cost of the player.

Please be aware that it is of utmost importance that you, as the parent, understand that if your child is selected as an MVGSA All-Star player, it DOES NOT guarantee your child's playing time during the regular tournaments and USA Softball District, State and National tournaments. For full playing rules, please refer to MVGSA All Star rules.

PARENT CONDUCT

- 1. MVGSA will not tolerate any behavior on the playing field or in the stands that would hinder or cause to hinder the spirit of good sportsmanship and cooperation of which we are trying to encourage.
- 2. At NO time shall MVGSA permit or condone foul and/or abusive language in the vicinity of any team event.
- 3. No alcoholic beverages, drug use, smoking, tobacco, or vaping is permitted in the vicinity of any team event.
- 4. The conduct of any guest(s) is the responsibility of the adult whose child participates on an MVGSA All-Star team.
- 5. MVGSA Charter By-Laws, along with MVGSA Rules and Regulations, will be enforced.
- 6. MVGSA Disciplinary Policy shall be enforced for all coaches, players and spectators.
