Today's Hub DeJong was once known as The 1st Annual Whatcom County All-star Baseball Tournament.

Hub DeJong, Jerry Smoot and countless others have dedicated many many years of their lives to the development of youth particularly in baseball and this tournament of 53 Great Years!

For the first 7 years tournament games were played at the Lynden fair grounds horse track. The HUB Tournament was then moved to Bender field complex as you see it today. 30 plus years have been played here the Bender Field complex.

For much of the early years expenses were covered by passing the hat. There were years that each district was to supply 2 umpires, anything to help offset the cost for a player/family to play this game. During a few early years, tournaments teams were requested to bring a bat to be donated and or raffled to tournament players.

Tournament committee meetings were often held at the home of Hub and Esther also at the Duke, Fairway Cafe and Bellingham McDonalds. It was rare for committee members to miss meetings and Esther's tupperware container of freshly made chocolate chip cookies "many say " the Best in all of Whatcom County.

Tournament formats have changed a bit over the years from 100% district All Star teams to advanced club teams to today's format of Major A / Minor A Ripken Competitive Teams, this includes house Teams in the Major B / Minor B divisions that allows additional players opportunities to compete in a local baseball tournament.

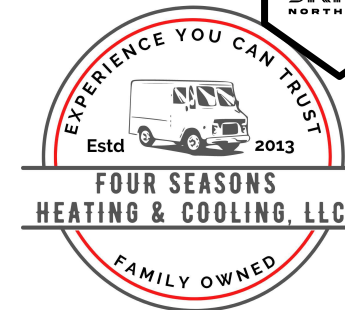

Hub DEJONG

A Legacy of Youth sports & Community



Hub DeJong moved to Lynden with his family from Sneek, Holland when he was just 3 months old. He attended Lynden schools, playing many different sports. In August of 1949, Hub married Esther and they were blessed with 3 children Brad DeJong, Karla Witman, and Wade DeJong all of Whatcom County. The joy of Hub's life were his 7 grandchildren: Blake, Lesha, Leslie, Jared, Jenna, Stacey & Dillon. He loved attending their various games and activities and was always the one cheering

the loudest. His given name was Harry DeJong but early on, his friends gave him the nickname Hub because his pitching style was very similar to that of baseball great Carl Hubbell and that name stuck with him for the rest of his life.

In 1974, Hub wanting to combine his love of sports and his love for kids, approached two other Lynden men and together they founded the Lynden Youth Sports Organization as it exists today. Hub and Esther gave countless hours of their time to insure that this program met the needs of all of the youth in the community. Hub took great pride in knowing that his efforts through LYS helped contribute to the successes of both the Lynden and Lynden Christian sports programs which presently have over 50 state titles combined. Hub was also a driving force in the development of what is now known as Bender Fields.

In 1973, Hub and his good friend, Jerry Smoot hatched an idea to start an all-star baseball tournament for local teams. The first tournament had 8 teams and was held at the Lynden fairgrounds. This tournament, with the help of many volunteers, has been a great success for the past 50 years.

Continuing the Legacy

The Hub and Esther DeJong Memorial Fund was setup to help continue the legacy that Hub and Esther began so many years ago, to support all youth in participation in all extra-curricular activities. A visit with Jerry Smoot on his back porch is an engaging trip back into Whatcom County history. The nearest reference point of conversation is all that Smoot has done and continues to do, coaching youth sports across about five decades.

Very quickly the name of the late Hub DeJong of Lynden comes up as a co-collaborator with Smoot of the county's first Cal Ripken (age 12 and under) Baseball Tourney in 1973. So early was this that the Lynden fairgrounds was still the venue of play for several years. Smoot was the representative for Bellingham and DeJong for Lynden. Eventually all seven school districts of Whatcom County contributed their summer youth baseball all-stars to an event that gained in strength.

But it wasn't baseball or basketball (as much as those became his youth coaching passion) that Smoot was involved in as he attended Bellingham High School and graduated in the class of 1961. He was a swimmer and a gymnast. He has kept a diving pool in his back yard for more than 40 years, and he uses it also as a reward for good effort by the kids he coaches.

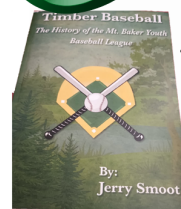
Smoot acknowledges that he and his four siblings didn't have the best of upbringing and he mentions not having a lot of fond memories growing up. They were often in foster homes as his father, Alonzo "Lonnie" Smoot, died at age 42 and his mother, Lois, died at age 41. From 1962 through 1966 Smoot served in the U.S. Marines, including a stint of about six months in Vietnam. He was spared being in combat by an assignment in communication whereby he earned security and top-secret clearance as well.

In a military leave back to Bellingham, he agreed to go on a blind date, American boys with Canadian girls, and a lasting match was struck. Jerry married his wife Joan, originally from Abbotsford, B.C. and they have two children, Jay and Jana. He went on to a 35-year career with Puget Sound Energy "climbing power poles," as he summarizes it, and all that exercise certainly helped to keep him fit for keeping up with the kids he has coached -- which stretches across the Mount Baker and Nooksack Valley and Meridian school districts. He passed on various opportunities to be a varsity-level coach.

Jerry and Joan personally hosted many summer players of the Bellingham M's, young hopefuls from throughout the West. Among the talent he watched in 1987 was a 17-year-old kid named Ken Griffey Jr. "I remember him playing in Bellingham, hitting home runs over the right field fence. That was when we were the baby Ms." Smoot has coached at various levels in Whatcom County for more than 40 years, largely at the middle school level, stretching across the Meridian, Nooksack Valley and Mount Baker school districts. When he wasn't coaching, he was helping mentor other, younger coaches. He has impacted the baseball community in myriad ways, from serving on the board of local baseball organizations to contributing his time and money to shoring up baseball facilities around the city. He has helped coach multiple generations of youth athletes in the Bellingham area, and impacting kids' lives is what brings him the most joy.
