
Registering for Interclub Races (2024-25)

The races are split in order to manage the size of the field. Look for races with Catamount (CAT) on the right.

Registration has to be made in the Adminskiracing site where you need to first set up an account. There is a link on the TSASSRA site.



They have updated their site and you will need to re-set pass words.

On the Admin SkiRacing site is where you go to actually register and pay for races. Once you have an account registered in the system you can find races. Search under Tri-state. Interclub is a division of Tri-State. We also refer to the racers in Tri-States scored racing division as the "Tri-State" team, which can add some confusion. Interclub Racers that are U12 or U14 may show up as eligible for a "Tri-State" race but this is due to Admin Ski Racings inability to separate the groups in Tri-State. This may also happen with CYSL races. There is an opportunity for IC racers to enter 1 Tri-State race per season, If the race organizer allows it. This may not be the case in U12/U14 races as the field size is very large. IC racers should not register for Full Gate SL (as opposed to stubby gates) Please contact Peter Chudy if there is a question.

You can find races by selecting calendar function. Select Tri-State and select Apply. This will show event by ski area.



You should register well in advance as the process typically **CLOSES THE WEDNESDAY BEFORE THE RACE. THERE IS NO DAY OF THE RACE REGISTRATION.**
