
Scholarships



Who was Sal Perez?

Anyone who knew Sal likely has a smile on their face when sharing a memory, whether it was a clever joke he played or a moment when he simply made their day a little brighter. Sal brought humor, kindness, and energy to everything he did, and the City of Holland was fortunate to have someone who embodied the mission of Holland Parks & Recreation in such a positive way.

A longtime fixture in the Holland community, Sal was a dedicated leader and contributor to Holland Parks & Recreation. He played a key role in developing recreational programs, including helping to launch the city's first men's touch football league. He also served as a site supervisor for volleyball, softball, and basketball, always bringing enthusiasm and care to each role. Sal had a heart for the kids in the community and had a positive influence on many throughout his life.

Sal's presence left a lasting impact on those around him, and he will always be remembered as a true staple in the Holland community.

What is the Sal Perez Youth Scholarship Fund and how is it used?

In honor of his legacy, the Sal Perez Youth Recreation Scholarship Program was created to ensure all children have the opportunity to participate in recreation, regardless of financial circumstances. The scholarship program helps cover a portion of registration fees for Holland Parks & Recreation programs and is available to children who live within the Holland city limits.

This fund is made possible through generous community support and fundraising efforts, including the annual Sal Perez Scholarship Softball Tournament—an event that continues to celebrate Sal's passion for sports, service, and bringing people together.

Over the last 10 years the impact of the Sal Perez Scholarship Program continues to grow. The funds that have been awarded to community members has tripled in recent years.
