Parade Float Rules

Parade Date: December 6th, 2025

Line-up 3:00 PM - 4:45 PM

NO ENTRIES WILL BE PERMITTED TO LINE UP AFTER 4:45 PM

Starting time 5:00 PM

These rules are designed to keep the parade safe. These rules may not apply to all entries. If you have questions please ask.

- 1. <u>All floats must be inspected on parade day for safety. If your float is deemed unsafe you will not be permitted to participate.</u>
- 2. All items must be secured on the float nothing can be dragging on the ground.
- 3. No one may get on or off the float once it has started down the parade route.
- 4. Throwing candy at the crowd, during the parade is NOT PERMITTED. Individuals walking the parade route may hand out/ roll candy or items.
- 5. No dangling legs over the edge of the float.
- 6. A responsible adult must be present if any children ride or walk with the float.
- 7. It is recommended that every float have a fire extinguisher.
- 8. No weapons/firearms allowed, except by law enforcement, on any float entry.
- 9. No smoking or alcoholic beverages on any parade entry at any time before or during the parade. Safety first!
- 10. All floats should have an 8" clearance from the ground.
- 11. The pulling vehicle must be able to travel slowly enough without stalling.
- 12. Float must be decorated on a minimum of 2 sides.
- 13. No fire or flame-producing devices are allowed on floats.
- 14. <u>Costumes worn by parade participants must conform to the standards of reasonable public taste. Costumes are to be family-friendly.</u>
- 15. Costumes can be Christmas-themed, but no participant may dress as Santa as to not confuse the children. Santa will be on the fire engine ending the parade.
- 16. NO PARTICIPANT WILL STOP THE MOTION OF THE PARADE PROCESSION UNLESS SPECIFICALLY INSTRUCTED BY A CHRISTMAS PARADE OFFICIAL OR POLICE OFFICER.
