

## City of Renton Parks & Recreation Youth Basketball Coach Code of Conduct

## SPORTSMANSHIP

Good sportsmanship is expected from the players, parents, and coaches. Children learn best by example. The following League Code of Conduct outlines parent, player, and coach behavior. Those parents/players unable to follow this Code may be requested to leave the game site or be excused from participating in the City's youth basketball program.

COACH CODE OF CONDUCT (before, during, and after the game...)

- Be respectful, positive, and supportive of the players, coaches, parents, and league officials/staff.
- The program is solely for the young people participating. It is not for any coach or parent but is designed to develop self-esteem, values, and skills in the participants.
- I am responsible not only for my conduct and performance, but also that of my assistants, players, and parents of the players.
- I will always use appropriate language and be respectful to coaches, participants officials, and city staff.
- I will provide an alcohol, tobacco, and drug-free environment for players and parents at all games and practices. I understand that failure to do so may result in termination.
- I will provide a positive environment by encouraging good sportsmanship and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sports event.
- Any coach receiving disciplinary action, from an official, site supervisor, coordinator, City staff, or school district employee during the season may be dismissed from coaching indefinitely.
- I have received a copy of the league rules for the City of Renton Recreation Division Youth Athletic programs, and I agree to play fair and by the rules.
- Any coach receiving two technical fouls during the season will be dismissed from coaching. Bench technical fouls on parents and players will be assessed by the coach.
- <u>All Coaches must remain seated during the entire game, except for timeouts, substitutions, or an injury.</u> Chairs will be provided to coaches approved to coach in the league.
