

Justice League Specific Rules

BASE RUNNING

1. Tags are “permitted”
2. Plays at every base are considered a force play. Includes base runners attempting to return to a base.
3. Runners advancing more than half way to the next base must continue to the base they are heading to. No rundowns or “Pickles”.
4. No touching home plate – players must run between the plate and the fence.
5. No sliding.
6. No Limit of courtesy runners.

PITCHING

1. With TWO Outs: if a male player is walked, they advance to second base. The following female batter has the option of accepting a walk or batting.
2. Plate AND mat are considered a strike.
3. Begin with a 1 ball and 1 strike count. Allowed 1 foul ball with two strikes. Any subsequent foul ball counts as a strikeout.
4. Pitching arc is 6’ to 12’.
5. Men hit the 12” ball and women hit 11” ball. Women can use 12” if they request.

BATTING ORDER

1. There is no limit on the number of batters that a team may have in their lineup. The batting order MUST have a female and male batter. Can’t be two men bat back to back.

Home Runs:

1. A team can hit two (2) home runs over the fence in a game. Any more past the limit result in an OUT.

General:

1. If you are arguing, then you are missing the point of the league. While we are “competitive” the purpose of the league is to bring various parts of the legal community together and provide a place to NOT engage in activity associated with the profession.
