- ☐ Get your player to practices and games on time.
- ☐ Communicate with coaches in a positive manner.
- ☐ Commit to all games and practices unless there is an unavoidable event. In such cases, please let coaches know as far in advance as possible.
- ☐ NOT address (speak to or yell at) the referees during a game. Doing so can result in a technical foul (2 points to the other team and the ball). Please make sure other family members know this as well.

By signing below, I understand that Rocky Mountain Youth Basketball & Cheer leadership and security can and will remove any fans who they deem are demonstrating disrespectful and/or disruptive behavior. In such a case the player(s) must also leave with the adult for the remainder of the day.

By signing below, I understand that Rocky Mountain Youth Basketball & Cheer offers full refunds up until teams are formed. Once teams are formed we unfortunately cannot make changes or offer refunds.

In the event that a player and/or parent does not abide by our league's player and parent agreements, the league reserves the right to dismiss a player from a team prior to the end of the season. The player forfeits any monies paid towards league fees. The uniform is the player's to keep once purchased.
