

Red Card Appeal Process/Rules All Soccer Leagues

It is the responsibility of each team rep/captain and/or coach to familiarize his team with the following league procedure.

Non-Qualifying Appeals

- a. Single yellow caution cards do not qualify for appeals
- b. Double yellow caution cards leading to red cards do not qualify for appeals

Rules

- a. All red cards require a minimum of a one game suspension
- b. Appeals will not be accepted or reviewed only after the suspension is issued by the league
- c. Suspensions will be published within 5 days after the game date
- d. Appeals must be submitted within 1 week after the suspension has been published by the league
- e. Appeals will only be accepted from the player

Appeal Process

- 1. Submit your appeal form to rosters@hillsboro-oregon.gov
- 2. Review During this phase, our internal appeal committee will review your appeal and will look at any available supporting documents. The league may contact you for additional information.
- 3. Decision Within 5 business days, the league will decide, if the appeal is approved or denied.

The City of Hillsboro will not be responsible for loss of property or injury suffered by any player or team during the time they play in the Hillsboro Adult Soccer League program.

It is the intention of the Parks and Recreation Department that the purpose of the soccer league is to provide fun and recreation for the participants. Therefore, protests of matches will be considered only because of extremely compelling reasons.
