



## **Lufkin Youth Basketball**

### **All-Star Selection Process**

#### **All-Star Head Coach Selection:**

The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place coaches from the end of season tournament will qualify to serve as the All-Star Showcase coaches. If a coach decides not to participate then the next placing coach will qualify until all spots have been secured. Each all-star head coach will have their choice of one assistant coach (who participated in the league) for the team. As a part of the All-Star selection process, Lufkin Parks and Recreation may consider past conduct and behavior before a final selection is made.

#### **Coaches Vote:**

Lufkin Parks and Recreation will email a ballot to each coach that participated during the 2025 regular season. (Head Coach and Assistant Coach from each league team will get to cast a ballot). Ballots will contain every player (per division) including their name, age, team, and jersey number. Once they receive the ballot via email or paper, (to be picked up at Lufkin Parks and Recreation) coaches will vote for a predetermined number players for each division. Ballots must be turned in via email or in person at Lufkin Parks and Recreation prior to the deadline. All coaches' votes will then be counted by Lufkin Parks and Recreation employees and witnessed by the Athletic Superintendent and Athletic Coordinator. If the final spot(s) for the team ends up in a voting tie, only the appointed manager (1<sup>st</sup> place Head Coach of that division) will be able to break such a tie. Once all players are voted in, the all-star head coaches will draft their teams per division.

#### **All-Star East Texas Pineywoods Showdown:**

Lufkin will participate in the East Texas Pineywoods Showdown on February 27, 28, and March 1<sup>st</sup>.

There will be games in Hudson and Huntington. Games will be played according to the rules from each gym.
