- Ask the officials or field supervisor in a calm manner to explain any rules I do not understand.
- Never physically injure or cause harm to an official or other participant.
- Refrain from the use of profanity or obscene gestures.
- Participate in a sportsmanlike and safe manner.
- Read and review the league rules and policies and adhere to them.
- Uphold the league philosophy of healthy competition and sportsmanship.
- Respect the park fields, sports equipment, and facility amenities.

If I do not participate according to this Code of Conduct, then depending on the seriousness of the offense(s), any or all of the following consequences may occur:

- Verbal warning
- Temporary removal from game
- Temporary suspension from league play (no refund of registration fee)
- Expulsion from the league entirely (no refund of registration fee)
