<b>Building and Grounds Committee</b>	Shall be responsible for the care and maintenance of the playing fields, buildings and grounds. Will investigate and recommend available, suitable sites and plans for development, including ways and means (works with the Finance Committee). It shall be responsible for recommending repair and improvement, other than normal maintenance, of the building and property of the Local League and supervise the performance of such approved projects.	Must have at least 3 Directors, and appointed members	<b>Vice President</b>	
<b>Equipment Committee</b>	Shall secure bids on needed supplies and equipment and make recommendations for their purchase to the Board of Directors. The committee shall be responsible for the proper issuance of such supplies and equipment and for the repair, cleaning and storage thereof at the close of the playing season.	Must have at least 3 Directors, and appointed members	<b>VP &amp; Equipment Manager</b>	
<b>Coaching Committee</b>	The committee shall interview and investigate prospective managers and coaches, and recommend acceptable candidates to the President, for subsequent appointment and approval by the Board of Directors. It shall, during the playing season, observe the conduct of the managers and coaches and report its findings to the President of the Local League. It shall also, at the request of the President or Board, investigate complaints concerning managers and coaches and make a report thereof to the President or Board of Directors as the case may be. This Committee may also include sub-committees assigned principal responsibility for specified divisions.	Must have at least 3 Directors, and appointed members	<b>VP &amp; Coaching Coordinator(s)</b>	
<b>Auxiliary Committee</b>	The committee shall coordinate the activities of the Auxiliary, it shall review and evaluate auxiliary projects for raising funds and the disposition of such profits, and make recommendations regarding them to the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall approve in advance all projects and actions of the Auxiliary Committee.	Treasurer & Auxiliary Manager, and 1 other Director, and appointed members	<b>Treasurer &amp; Auxiliary Manager</b>	
<b>Rules Committee</b>	If the Constitution, By-Laws, Rules of Order, or Standing Rules are being questioned or need interpretation, the committee shall investigate, research and issue orders or interpretations to the President, Board of Directors, or Local League as requested or as it deems necessary.	Must have at least 3 Directors, and appointed members	<b>President</b>	
<b>Umpire Committee</b>	Shall recruit, interview, and recommend to the President a staff of umpires, including an Umpire-In-Chief and replacement umpires. When appointed, the staff of umpires will be under the personal direction and responsibility of the Local League President, assisted by the Umpire-In-Chief who shall train, observe, and schedule staff.
