Further, I agree to pay for any medical or other expenses incurred because of injuries caused, directly or indirectly, by participation in this program. I release the City of Kearney, its employees, coaches, Board of Aldermen, and any other representatives of all liability. I have read the Kearney Parks and Recreation code of conduct that is included on this waiver and agree to abide by it.

Kearney Parks and Recreation Code of Conduct

Unsportsmanlike conduct by a coach, player, parent, or fan, whether before, during or after a game is of concern to Kearney Parks and Recreation. Each team is responsible for the conduct of its players, coaches, parents, and fans at all Kearney Parks and Recreation games at home or away. Kearney Parks and Recreation policies and procedures make it clear that the department has the responsibility to act when a team does not, or cannot, adequately control the conduct of the players, coaches, and fans. The published game rules for each sport contain the standards of sportsmanship to be enforced by game officials. Please report any unsportsmanlike conduct to any game official or parks and recreation staff.

The use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs at any Kearney Parks and Recreation activity is prohibited. Absolutely no drinking alcohol before, during, or after the game or anywhere in the park. This is a zero-tolerance rule, and anyone suspected by the umpire of being inebriated will be disqualified from participation for the rest of the season.

Frequently the Parks & Recreation Department takes video or photographs of people enjoying programs, special events, or parks and facilities. These videos and photographs are for the City of Kearney publications, website, social media and/or cable programs. They are used at the discretion of the City of Kearney and become its sole property.
