1. PLAYER REGISTRATION REQUIRED FOR ALL TEAMS

Rosters sheets are available online or upon request. Roster sheet must be filled out completely with signatures of all players and manager(s). Final rosters (no additions after this date) are due the first scheduled game.

2. REGISTRATION FEE:

Registration begins **June 17th, 2025 at 7:00am**. Space is limited. Registration will be filled on a first come first serve basis. Registration should be done online. If paying by check or sponsor you have 2 options.

- a. You can bring your check into register at our customer service desk (2117 West River Road North) starting on June 16th at 9am and have our front desk register you. OR
- b. You can register online with your credit card to hold your spot while waiting for your sponsor check, once you bring in your sponsor check we will then put the money back on your credit card.

LEAGUE FEES: \$350.00

The season will begin the week of August 10th run into the week of October 12th (9 weeks, 9 games scheduled, 7 games guaranteed *(not counting forfeits)*). Eight team leagues will have a 7-game regular season followed by a 2-game playoff.
