

# Consent for Transportation of Minor

**Junior Lions Youth Football policy:** Local travel consists of travel to training, practice, and competition that does not include coordinated overnight stay(s). Insofar as Junior Lions Youth Football generally does not arrange for local travel for individual players, Covered Individuals (coaches, volunteers, etc.) who are not also acting as a legal guardian, absent emergency circumstances, are restricted from traveling alone with a minor unless specifically authorized in writing to do so; otherwise, travel must include at least one other person. In any case where a staff member and/or volunteer is involved in a minor athlete's local travel, a parental release is required in advance.
