Eighth Grade Scholarship Application Process

PTO and BOOSTERS Submissions

There are two simultaneous scholarship contests that must be submitted to the main office on or before Wednesday, April 7th, with stated deadline as "the end of the school day":

1. The Boosters Athletic Scholarship is essay-based and will be accompanied by the requisite forms filled out by former Bulldogs coaches (i.e. students will be turning in a "packet") 2. The PTO Academic Scholarship is questionnaire-based and will also be submitted as a multi-page "packet"

Both organizations will arrange to have their respective applications reviewed fairly and anonymously by a panel of judges. Students were specifically instructed to AVOID identifying themselves in the content of their applications. Likewise, if any "identifiers" appear at the time of submission, such as a name on an envelope, it should be removed/blacked out before it is filed in the accordion file box.

IMPORTANT: Student applicants should be able to clearly distinguish the particular scholarship as "Boosters" or "PTO" as they are handing it over to the school administrator!

Please use the identification key provided when accepting applications. For the sake of ease and simplicity, please label PTO applications as P-# and in similar fashion, please label Boosters applications as B-# directly on the envelope before filing. This key will remain in the hands of only Mrs. Conger, Mr. Gruber, and this school administrative copy. After determining the winning entries, applications will be reconciled with students' names.
