Due to the difficulty and high cost of obtaining liability insurance, the BBA requires the execution of the following liability Waiver and Release. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in registering yourself and your ward for participation in this/these program(s) you will be waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages, or loss you or your ward might sustain through participation in this/these program(s) listed below.

As a participant of the parent/guardian of a participant in this program, I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury, and I agree to assume the full risk of any injuries, damages or loss which I or my ward may sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with, or in any way associated with the activities of the program.

I do hereby fully waive, release and discharge the BBA, it's officers, agents, servants, representatives, employees and program board members from any and all claims for injuries, damages or loss which I or my ward may sustain or which may accrue to me or my ward arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with the activities of the program.

I further agree to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the BBA, its officials, agents, servants, representatives, employees and program board members from any and all claims for injuries, damages or loss sustained by me or my ward arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with the activities of the program.

In the even of any emergency, I authorize program officials to secure from any licensed hospital, physical and/or medical personnel any treatment deemed necessary for my or my ward's immediate care and agree that I will be responsible for payment of any and all medical services rendered.

I agree to the following guidelines:

- •I will not argue with umpires' decisions and will not use foul or profane language.
- •I will be on time to practice and games.
- •I will always give 100% on the bench, in the game, or in practice.
- •I will always encourage my teammates even if I am not playing.
- •I understand that it takes the whole team to play a game and I will play any position that the coach wants me to with the best of my ability.
- •My uniform will be worn properly at all times (shirt tucked in, hat straight).
- •I will address all staff members with "Coach", "Sir", "Ma'am", "Mr.", "Mrs."
- •I will always be prepared by bringing all of my equipment to every practice/game.
- •I understand it is not my parent's responsibility to bring my equipment and uniforms to games/practices.
- •I WILL ALWAYS BE POSITIVE and HAVE FUN.

#### **Parent Code of Conduct**

I agree to the following guidelines:

- •I agree to read and support the above Player Code of Conduct
- •I agree to support the coaches, umpires and officials with the overriding goal of teaching good sportsmanship, teamwork, and self-discipline.
- •I will refrain from arguing with umpires' decisions, criticizing players on the field, or using loud, abusive, profane, or foul language.
- •I understand that unsportsmanlike behavior on my part can result in my being asked to leave the area and that my child's team may forfeit the game if I refuse to do so.
- •I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of my personal desire for them to win.
- •I will respect the officials and their authority during the games and will never question, discuss, or confront at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
- •I will leave instruction during the game to the coaching staff. I will NOT coach from behind the backstop.
- •I will not yell at the umpires.
- •I will not use tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs at any BBA sponsored event.
- •I understand that if I have a complaint about a procedure, policy or coach that I need to submit it, in writing, to the Beauregard Baseball Board in order for any action to be considered in the matter.
