

Baseball Bat Requirements (02/10/2026)

Approved Bats

Note: USSSA Labeled Bats Are Not To Be Used During In-House Play for ages 12 & under.

T-Ball

Only bats that are labeled for T-Ball. Up to 2 1/4" diameter, 26" Maximum length.
USA Baseball stamp only.

All youth baseball bats used in the **Rookies- 7/8, Minors- 9/10/, Majors-11/12 in house leagues** must not exceed 33" in length and cannot have a barrel diameter larger than 2 5/8-inches. Also, they must have the USA certified stamp, however, **solid one-piece wood barrel bats do not require a USA Baseball logo. Composite bats are allowed as long as they meet these specifications.**

13/14 (Seniors)

Bats up to 2 5/8 inch diameter and no more than 34 inches in length. USA or USSSA certified stamp.
Baseball bats with a 2 5/8 inch diameter and a drop of -3 are required to have the BBCOR label.

15-18 (Stallions)

Only bats labeled as BBCOR .50, no greater than -3 drop are allowed, maximum length of 36".
Solid one-piece wood barrel bats do not require a USA Baseball logo These are bats that are approved for high school baseball.
