## **MINORS**

Ages: 11,12 and 13 years old by July 31 of the current year

Length of game: 7 innings or time

Dimensions: bases 75', foul line 200', centerfield 240', pitcher's plate 52'6"

Bats Sizes: Bats 32" and under. Barrels 2 5/8 max and -10 ratio.

Wooden bats ok, 32" in length. All personal bats must be approved by the commissioner.

Balls: 9" Baseball

## **Playing Rules**

 NFHS baseball rules, with the exceptions and variations of FJBC rules and regulations listed below.

- 2. Games start at 6:00 pm and end at 7:50 pm. The 1st siren will sound at 7:50 pm. No new inning will begin after 7:50 pm. The 2nd siren will sound at 8:10 pm. All play stops at 8:10 pm. If the final inning of the game is not completed by 8:10 pm the score will revert back to the score from the end of the previous inning.
- 3. An inning (except 7th inning) ends and a new inning starts the moment 3 outs are made or 5 runs have scored. The 7th inning ends after the visiting team completes its half of the inning and the home team is ahead or the 7th inning is completed.
- 4. Each team will field 9 players, but not less than 8.
- 5. All players will bat the entire game. The batting order cannot be changed.
- 6. Open substitution/re-entry rule applies. No player may sit out more than 2 consecutive innings.
- 7. Batter will wear a helmet approved by the league.
- 8. If a home run is hit over the fence all runners preceding the batter will count even if more than 5 runs are scored. There are unlimited runs in the 7th inning.
- 9. A player cannot pitch more than 4 innings per game or 7 innings a week. (Monday through Saturday). Note: 1 pitch by a player will be considered an inning pitched.
- 10. If a pitcher hits 3 batters in one inning or 4 batters in one game, they will be relieved of that position for the remainder of the game.
- 11. Third strike rule does apply: **Hot Plate** rule in effect.
- 12. Home plate can be stolen.
- 13. The infield fly rule does apply.
- 14. Mandatory slide rule: All runners must slide to avoid contact in all close plays to avoid collision and injury.
- 15. Lead offs are allowed. Balks will be called.
- 16. All runners must slide to avoid contact in all close plays. (Umpire Judgement)
- 17. No Jewelry.
- 18. No steel cleats.
- 19. All male players must wear a protective cup. Failure to do so will result in the player sitting out that game or until the infraction is corrected.
