CIRCUIT MEETS: When we travel to circuit meets, each athlete will need to pay \$5 to the meet host. to compete at the meet. The \$5 per athlete fee will allow the athlete to participate in an unlimited number of events. Spectators' entry fee is \$5 per person. Parents are responsible for their child's transportation to and from the track meets. Weekly meet schedules will be available at the practice each week no later than Tuesday of that week and meet schedules will also be available at www.teamsideline.com/waco.
