

NEVADA CITY LITTLE LEAGUE VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT

\$150 Snack Shack Deposit Check (held on file)

The purpose of this document is to outline and agree upon the expectations of the parent volunteers in the league.

NCLL collects a \$150 deposit per child to ensure snack shack volunteer coverage. The goal of our volunteer program and this document is not to cash your deposit check. Rather, our goal is to spread the volunteer duties around equally throughout each team and each family so that everyone participates evenly, and no one has to do significantly more or significantly less than anyone else. Your help is greatly appreciated!

Parents are required to work a certain number of snack shack shifts per family (typically ~3/child), dependent upon number of games played at Pioneer Park and players per team. Shifts are approximately 2-3 hours in length, and will likely require opening and/or closing. Parents working the snack shack should plan on arriving 30 minutes prior to the game, and staying approximately 30 minutes after the game to close up the snack shack.

The “Team Mom/Dad” has the responsibility to put together the volunteer schedule for their team. No families are exempted from volunteer duties. It is the responsibility of each parent to record each snack shack shift worked in the volunteer log. The deposit check will be returned or destroyed after your volunteer responsibilities are completed at the end of the season. Partial refunds are not available.

This deposit is *not* a “buy out” option. Some teenagers *may* be available for hire at your own expense. However, there must be a parent volunteer on the cash register, and anyone on the BBQ must be at least 16 yrs old.

There are additional volunteer responsibilities that need to be fulfilled during the course of the year, and your team’s Manager will explain those once the season begins.

By signing this agreement, you understand the volunteer requirement and understand that the \$150 DEPOSIT will be forfeited for any of the following 3 reasons:

1. You do not fulfill the volunteer snack shack requirements.
2. You fail to work a shift that you signed up for and don't find a replacement.
3. You fail to notify the volunteer or snack shack coordinator that another person will be working for you.
