

ADULT SPORTS RECREATION LEAGUE



CARD ADULT SPORTS Programs will offer 5 Divisions of Recreation Level Play.

Depending on community interest and registration numbers, each Division may be divided into subdivisions

BASKETBALL/SOCCER/VOLLEYBALL

- **Rec A** A₁ A₂
- **Rec B** B₁ B₁
- **Rec C** C₁ C₂

SOFTBALL LEAGUES ONLY

- **Rec D** D₁ D₂
- **Rec E** E₁ E₂
- **Rec Novice**

- **Rec Open:** Open division will be used when there are not enough teams to create multiple divisions
- **Rec Senior:** Senior divisions will identify maximum age of participants (ex 40+)

REC A

- **Player/Team Skill:** Advanced-Highly Skilled
- **Player/Team Experience:** Likely has participated in many years of organized league play
Likely participated in HS Varsity, College, Pro/Semi-Pro play
- **Player/Team Knowledge:** Has strong knowledge of sport and rules of the game
- **Player/Team Motivation:** Strong Competition / Positive Social Interaction / Health & Fitness
More challenging sport environment
Outcome of game is of high importance
- **Standings/Playoffs** Division Standings will be kept
Playoffs offered to top 4 teams

REC B

- **Player/Team Skill:** Intermediate-Moderate to High Skill Level
- **Player/Team Experience:** May have participated in some organized league play
May have participated in some HS, College, Intramural, Club play
- **Player/Team Knowledge:** Has some knowledge of sport and rules of the game
- **Player/Team Motivation:** Friendly Competition / Positive Social Interaction / Health & Fitness
Outcome of game has some importance
- **Standings/Playoffs** Division standings will be kept
Playoffs offered to top 4 teams

REC C

- **Player/Team Skill:** Beginner/Novice
- **Player/Team Experience:** Inexperienced – Some Experience
No College/Pro/Tournament Experience Allowed
- **Player/Team Knowledge:** May or may not have knowledge of sport and rules of the game
Rules may be modified to meet wants/needs of division
- **Player/Team Motivation:** Friendly & Fun game play / Positive Social Interaction / Health & Fitness
Outcome of Game is of little to no importance
- **Standings/Post Season** Division standings may or may not be kept
Playoffs may or may not be offered

DIVISIONS OF PLAY

REC OPEN

- Player/Team Skill: Open to all Skill Levels
- Player/Team Experience: Open to all Experience Levels
- Standings/Post Season: Division standings may or may not be kept
Playoffs may or may not be offered

REC SENIOR

- Player/Team Age: Participation in division is determined by age rather than skill/experience
- Standings/Playoffs: Division standings may or may not be kept
Playoffs may or may not be offered

PLAYING OUT OF DIVISION

Players/Teams that participate in A Division play may not participate in C or Rec/Novice Division Play

*Softball Players/Teams that participate in D Division play may not participate in E2 or Rec/Novice Division Play

LEAGUE MOVEMENT

Teams may be moved from their league of choice, at the discretion of the Adult Sports Department, should it be deemed beneficial to the CARD ADULT SPORTS program.

Prior team history and records will be considered upon league creation.

League champions MAY be moved up to a higher Division for the subsequent season if deemed appropriate.

Teams that struggle in each division MAY also be moved to a lower division.

The goal is to facilitate proper league placement over the course of time.
