



Wilson Premier Youth Baseball (WPYB)

Player Ejection / Suspension Policy

1. When a player is ejected from the game, the player must remain in the bench area for the remainder of the game and any post-game meeting. If a player does not, the player may face a more severe suspension penalty as determined by the Board of Directors.
2. Once the Board of Director has determined the penalty for a player who has been suspended due to ejection from a game or other disciplinary action, the player must comply with the following requirements.
 - A. The suspended player must arrive in full uniform for the team's pre-game practice.
 - B. The suspended player must stay in the bench area for the entire game including the manager's post-game meeting.
 - C. If the player does not arrive in uniform for the pre-game practice and does not stay for the game, the player has not completed the penalty for the suspension. The player must appear at the next game and fully comply with sections A. and B.
 - D. When a manager suspends a player with the approval of WPYB, the player must comply with the requirements as stated in sections A. and B.
 - E. If a parent, grandparent or other relative or fan of a player is ejected from a game and the ejection results in the suspension of a player, the player must comply with the requirements as stated in sections A. and B.
 - F. If a parent or guardian presents a personal check to WPYB and that check is returned for insufficient funds or any other reason and the player is suspended, the player does not need to attend the pre-game and game.
