



How to make payments within WPYB (*aka NO CASH*)

Rule #1- Except when purchasing concession stand items, never give a manager, coach, or league representative cash payments without Board Member Approval. All team managers are aware of this rule.

Rule #2 - Never write a check or money order for league items (**excluding pictures**) to anyone except "WPYB".

Except at our concession stands, Wilson Premier Youth Baseball (known as "WPYB") does not accept cash for registration or any type of league payment. Examples include **but are not limited to:**

- Player registration
- Fundraiser payment (Candy/Charity-Mania)
- Fundraiser buyout
- Tournament team payments or uniform sales
- Banner or team sponsorship
- Brewer fundraiser ticket purchases

We will only accept personal, business checks, bank checks and money orders. It is important to note that WPYB will not accept checks from anyone who previously bounced a check and will impose a \$20 charge immediately upon receiving notice of a bounced check. The player associated with the bounced check will be suspended from all league activities until the original payment and \$20 fee are reimbursed. If you accept a 3rd party check from anyone for fundraising, you are ultimately responsible for that bounced check.

Please have all checks written as described below to allow for ease in tracking. This is especially helpful for when the author of the check has a different last name than the player.
