Timeline for communication on events and building closure:

- Morning closure/delays(rec building): 8 a.m notice on Facebook, OR recreation center building closure will follow school closures for ice/snow inclement weather
- Evening activities/games: Decisions will be made by 3 p.m. regarding games.
 CVRC encourages volunteer coaches to do the same regarding practices.
 (school closures will be followed if there are school games/practices to follow that evening)
- Weekend and/or Holiday activities/games: Decisions will be made by 7 a.m. (school closures will be followed if there are school games/practices to follow that weekend/holiday)

Communication plan regarding home events:

For traveling events, CVRC will be notified and you can skip step 2: all other steps remain the same.

- 1. **CVRC Facebook**: Updates will be provided on Facebook as immediately as possible. If you don't have Facebook please ask a coach or friend to update you if they see anything. This is the most general way for us to get information out to a lot of people quickly.
- The Director and/or persons in charge will contact the league or visiting towns directly: Updates will be made to traveling teams as soon as possible. Persons in charge will utilize direct contacts or group league chats for updates to traveling teams.
- 3. **Direct message and/or contact to coaches:** Updates will be then provided to the coaches and game workers for CVRC. Director and/or employed persons, and board members with CVRC will update via coach group messages, phone calls, or in person on event updates.

- **-Coaches will notify parents:** Coaches will utilize their parent group chats to notify parents/guardians of players on the event cancellation regarding ice or snow.
- 4. Team Sideline: Team Sideline messaging communication will be utilized to update all families registered for that sport. The goal is to streamline Team Sideline as a communication hub for CVRC happenings and updates. As more families are utilizing this service this mode of communication will happen sooner. (Parents/coaches, if you are NOT currently receive Team Sideline updates please make contact with CVRC if you have a child participating in CVRC sports.)

CVRC would like to note they desire all families to always make the decision they feel is SAFEST for their families regarding travel to play, whether that be in Caney or a game in another town.
