

### Wood Bat Local Rules:

- 5 Run Limit per inning. If you are down by 6 runs going into the last inning you cannot win. However the final inning should be played for future point differential.
- Unlimited courtesy runners. Courtesy runners may only run once per inning.
- Outfielders cannot throw out at first base.
- All bases will be played like the double base at first. Players may run through 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> base as if there is a double plate. If players want to go to the next base they must first return to tag the over run base before continuing. This rule is in effect to avoid collisions on base.
- Players may use the pitching screen. If a ball hits the screen the player is out.
- Commitment line is a line drawn between third base and home plate; once a runner crosses it, they are committed to scoring and cannot return to third base.
- When the pitching screen is in use the halo rule is in effect.
