Men's 7v7 Soccer Rules

All games will be played in accordance with FIFA Laws of the Game, with the following modifications for 7v7 play:

General Format

- No offsides in seven-a-side soccer.
- Each team fields seven players, including a goalkeeper.
- A minimum of five players is required to start and continue a game. If a team
 falls below five players, the game may proceed only at the referee's
 discretion and if the match remains competitive.

Jerseys & Player Identification

1. Numbered Jerseys

- All players must wear permanently numbered jerseys of the same color by the first game.
- Numbers must be visible on either the front or back.
- Players without regulation jerseys will not be allowed to play.
- Teams unable to field five properly uniformed players plus a goalie will forfeit the game.

2. Picture ID Requirement

- All rostered players must present valid photo ID to the referee before every game.
 - Acceptable ID includes: driver's license, state-issued ID, school ID, passport, etc.
 - NO ID − NO PLAY − NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Late-arriving players must check in with ID before entering the game.
- Team managers are responsible for ensuring all players have checked in with the referee.

Jewelry and Safety

3. Jewelry Prohibited

- Jewelry of any kind is not allowed, including rings, posts, bracelets, earrings, and necklaces.
- Emergency medical ID bracelets or necklaces may be worn but must be taped securely to the body.
- Players wearing jewelry will be shown a **yellow card**, asked to leave the field to remove the item, and may not return until the next dead ball.

4. Piercing Plugs

- **Pliable rubber or silicone plugs** worn for safety are allowed and not considered jewelry.
- However, referees may deem any item unsafe and require its removal.

Gameplay & Field Regulations

5. Game Duration

Games consist of two 25-minute halves with a 5-minute halftime.

6. Slide Tackling

- No sliding or slide tackling is permitted by field players.
- Goalkeepers may slide only within the penalty box to retrieve the ball, but not feet-first into an opponent in possession of the ball.
- Violations result in an **indirect free kick** for the opposing team.
- Referees may issue **yellow or red cards** for sliding fouls that are careless, reckless, or violent.

7. Substitutions

- Substitutes may enter without referee permission unless they have not yet checked in with the referee.
- Substitutes must wait until the player being replaced has exited the field.

8. Field Dimensions

- Games are played on natural grass fields, approximately 45 yards wide by 75 yards long.
- Goals are 18 feet wide by 6 feet tall.

Scheduling & Roster Rules

9. Game Time = Forfeit Time

- Games will **not be rescheduled** under any circumstances.
- If a team cannot field the minimum number of players at the scheduled start time,
 a forfeit will be declared.
- Teams will then have 15 minutes to get at least six players per team ready to play; during that time, teams may borrow players from each other to meet the minimum requirement.

10. Rosters

- All players must appear on the **official roster** of one of the participating teams.
- If a team falls below five eligible players at any point, **referees will not officiate** the game.
