

CYO Severe Weather Policy 2025 Playoffs

- If game starts with no thunder and lightning in the area and weather moves in game will be stopped. 30 minutes from last seen lightning or heard thunder game can resume. If the game makes it to halftime, the game will be considered official. If the game does not make it to halftime and less than 10 minutes has been played the game will be rescheduled.
- **If game cannot start** due to multiple thunder and lightning delays game will be rescheduled.
- If game is delayed (75 minutes allotted for 6/7th grade, 90 minutes for 8th grade) due to thunder and lightning. We will move to two x 20-minute halves. If that is not possible, we will move to 2 x 15-minute halves. If neither of those is a possibility we will move to 2 x 10-minute halves. If none of these are possible within your game time allotment games will be rescheduled.
- If more than 12 games must be rescheduled, we will be shortening games to 2 x 15-minute halves.
- If your game needs to be rescheduled your team must be available to play Monday-Friday next week. Games can start as early as 4:30pm and end as late as 9pm. No special requests will be granted.
- If teams are not present and ready to play it will result in a forfeit.
