Party Rental Guidelines

Thank you for choosing to have your party at the Placerville Aquatics Center! Listed below are a few details that we would like you to be aware of before your party. If you have any questions regarding your party, please contact the Recreation Department at (530) 642-5232. We hope you enjoy your time at the pool!

1. The Pool Party rate of \$140 includes up to 20 participants, including chaperones. Regular admission rates apply to any additional persons and is payable at the time of admission to the facility. The party area can accommodate 20-30 people. Advance notice is required for party rentals exceeding 30 people and is subject to Recreation Staff approval. Requests for approval must be submitted at least 1 week in advance.
2. **After your rental, party-goers are welcome to stay and enjoy the remainder of Public Swim at no additional charge!**
3. Chaperones must be responsible individuals, ages 16 and older and are required as follows:
 - Children under the age of 5: 1 chaperone for every 3 children
 - Children age 5-9: 1 chaperone for every 5 children
 - Children age 10 -16: 1 chaperone for every 10 children
4. Pool Parties include the reservation of the shaded party area, with tables and chairs. Upon your arrival, an Aquatic Center staff member will help direct your party to their designated area, where tables and chairs will be provided. During your party, please notify a Pool Manager if you need assistance, or would like a brief facility orientation for you or your guests. Applicants are responsible for any additional set-up, decorations, and general clean-up of the party area at the conclusion of the party.
5. Refunds are available if canceling 5 or more **business days** prior to your rental. **No refunds** will be granted after this deadline, unless reservation is booked by another party.
6. Decorations are permitted in the party shade structure area only. **No latex balloons or confetti.** If tape is used, only masking tape is permitted.
7. Pool Parties are held during Public Swim hours. Pool Party groups will be sharing the facility with other users.
8. Parking availability is not guaranteed and may be limited due to other events in the area.
9. Pool Party groups shall use the main facility entrance unless otherwise instructed.
10. All guest behavior is subject to management staff approval, and all facility rules will remain in effect during Pool Parties. A manager can discuss facility rules with your group if desired.
11. Rafts and other flotation devices, including water wings and swimsuits with flotation sewn-in are not permitted in the pool. Coast Guard approved lifejackets are permitted.
 12. Guests must be 48 inches tall and must weigh less than 300lbs to ride the waterslide. Only one person is permitted on the slide at a time. We cannot make any exceptions to these rules.
13. Food must be eaten in designated areas along the seat wall and under the shade structures during Pool Parties. No barbeques or open flames are permitted. No glass containers.
14. Proper swim attire is required to swim at the Aquatic Center. The facility dress code requires all guests to dress in a manner consistent with a family atmosphere. We encourage all of our guests to wear sunscreen!

FACILITY RULES

- All persons entering during public swimming must pay an entrance fee.
- Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied, and closely supervised, by a responsible person 16 years or older.
- Coast Guard approved Type II and Type III lifejackets are permitted. No other flotation devices or swimming aids are allowed.
- Non-swimmers and those in lifejackets must be with an adult at all times, and are required to stay in shallow water.
- Diving is allowed only in designated areas of the deep end.
- Running and rough play are not allowed.
- Swim attire must be clean and appropriate for our family-oriented facility.
- Children not bathroom trained must wear a swim diaper.
- Food is allowed in seating areas, away from the edge of the pool.
- Loitering in showers or bathroom areas is not permitted.
- The following are not allowed in the pool area: alcohol, tobacco products, smoking, e-cigarettes, weapons, glass containers, bikes, skateboards, scooters, and gum.
- Animals are not allowed on the pool deck, with the exception of service animals.
- Spitting and nose blowing in the water is prohibited.
- Admission will be refused to any person with skin lesions, infections, or contagious disease.
- Valuables should not be left unattended. The Placerville Recreation Department is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
- All patron behavior is subject to manager approval.

DIVING BOARD RULES

- Only swimmers who are confident in deep water, and able to swim the width of the pool, are permitted to use the diving board.
- Swimmers must remove lifejackets when using the diving board.
- One person is permitted on the board at a time.
- No running on the diving board.
- Only one bounce on the end of the board is permitted.
- Divers must jump or dive straight off the end of the diving board.
- Only forward jumps, dives, and flips are permitted.
- After entering the water, divers must swim directly to the nearest ladder or under the rope.
- When the diving board is open, swimming in the deep end is not permitted.
- Lifeguards, at their discretion, may stop any diving activity deemed unsafe.



SLIDE RULES

- ✓ The operational limit for the slide is one person, 300 pounds.
- ✓ Participants must be at least 48 inches tall to ride the slide.
- ✓ Walk on stairs and use handrails.
- ✓ Wait for permission from the slide dispatcher before entering slide, then enter from a sitting position.
- ✓ Slide feet-first, lying down with legs straight in front and arms crossed over chest.
- ✓ Arms and hands must remain inside the flume at all times.
- ✓ Goggles and swimwear with zippers, rivets, or metal are not permitted.
- ✓ Stopping on the slide and climbing up the slide is not permitted.
- ✓ After entering the water, quickly exit the slide area and follow the lifeguard's directions.
- ✓ Pregnant women and persons with heart conditions or back trouble should not ride.

ACTIVITY POOL RULES

- ✓ Children must be accompanied, and closely supervised, by a responsible adult.
- ✓ Children ages 2 and younger must remain within arm's reach of their attendant at all times, no one over the age of 8 is permitted in the activity pool.
- ✓ Participants are encouraged to turn valves, pull ropes, and interact with the play structure.
- ✓ Hanging and swinging on pull ropes is not permitted.
- ✓ Climbing on pipes, handrails, or the outside of the play structure is not permitted.
- ✓ No running, jumping or diving permitted.
- ✓ Only one person on the slide at a time.
- ✓ Participants must slide feet first, on back, and immediately leave the landing area upon exiting.
- ✓ Children not bathroom trained must wear a swim diaper. Poolside diaper changing is not permitted.
- ✓ Food is allowed along the seat wall only.
