LEAGUE DETAILS

GAMES: League games are held at El Dorado High School, Markham, Gold Trail and Sutter's Mill. All Kindergarten-6th grade division games play on Saturdays with the 7th-8th grade division games playing on Sundays. League games start the weekend of January 17th. Schedules will be posted online at www.teamsideline.com/placerville.

FORMAT: Teams are guaranteed 8 games and a jersey. First place teams of the 3rd-8th grade leagues will receive individual awards. All participants in Kindergarten-2nd grade leagues will receive participation awards.

REGISTRATION: If a player would like to request a coach they must do so at the time of registration. If a coach is not requested, they will be placed on a team with others from the same school or the closest available area. Players must reside within El Dorado County. Players who have been requested on a team must indicate so at the time of registration. Roster requests are not guaranteed.

VOLUNTEER COACHES NEEDED

The City of Placerville is looking for adults to volunteer their time, energy, and talent as coaches. The Recreation Department needs a minimum of 160 coaches and assistants to conduct the 2026 season. Coaches and assistant coaches are required to complete: a coaching packet, concussion training and live scan, and attend the coaches meeting. Head coaches receive free registration for one child. LEAGUE DIVISIONS

If a player is to be placed into an older league based on their age, they must be that age as of **January 1, 2026**. We offer boys and girls divisions with the exception of coed for kindergarten.
