

LYSC PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

-I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in youth soccer by following this Parent Code of Conduct Pledge:

-I will not yell at or argue with referees.

-I will not force my child to participate in soccer.

-I will not behave negatively at games and I will treat referees, opposing parents and opposing players with respect.

-I will learn the rules of the sport.

-I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or other event.

-I will never use profanity.

-I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.

-I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.

-I will support coaches and officials working with my child, to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

-I will not attempt to coach my child from the sidelines.

-I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of alcoholic beverages, drugs, chewing tobacco or smoking material of any kind, and will refrain from their use at all events.

-I will remember that the game is for youth, not for adults.

-I will do my very best to make soccer fun for my child.

-I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.

-I promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can; such as being a respectable fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.

-I will not bring any animals to a game, practice, or other event to promote a safe environment for all participants and spectators.
